

RULES OF PLAY

1. USGA rules govern all play unless modified by local rules.
2. Local Rule: Ball coming to rest in desert areas or ravines — Player may drop a ball within two club-lengths of the point of entry. A one stroke penalty is recommended.
3. Lake and irrigation water are reclaimed! Please do not drink.
4. Out-of-Bounds is defined by white stakes, perimeter fences and bordering property line/walls.

ETIQUETTE

1. Pace of Play: Please play ready golf — Every group's target time is 4 hours, 2 hours per nine holes. In order to maintain a good pace, please make sure you are behind the group in front of you rather than ahead of the group behind you. Slow groups will be asked to pick up and move forward when deemed to be unnecessarily holding up players behind them.
2. Private Property: Please do not enter private property. Entering private property around the course is considered trespassing and will not be tolerated.
3. Lost Balls: Please limit search to 3 minutes.
4. Golf Cart Rules: 90° rule is in effect unless directed otherwise by the golf pro shop staff.
5. Dress Code: Golf shirts with collars are preferred. Cutoffs, gym shorts, tank tops and halter tops will not be allowed. Metal spikes will not be allowed at any time.
6. Food and Beverages: Other than bottled water, outside beverages will not be allowed. Personal coolers may be brought during summer months only.
7. Player Responsibility: Please repair your ball marks and someone else's if able, replace (winter) or sand (summer) your divots, and rake bunkers after your shot. Please help us leave the course in better shape than you found it.
8. Lightning: If a thunderstorm is in the area, please leave the golf course. If unable to get off of the course, please find shelter in low lying ditches or bunkers.
9. Flash Floods: In the event of a flood, please be aware of low lying areas and washes as they will fill quickly and should be avoided.
10. No carts on any par 3's. Carts with a disabled flag are permitted closer access to greens and tees, as course conditions allow.
11. Do not drive golf carts through dry stream beds.
12. Cart damage is the responsibility of the driver.
